Dear Parent/Guardian,

Today it has been confirmed that two high school students have tested positive for COVID-19. Working through our safety protocols, all students and staff who have been in close contact, which is defined as being within 6 feet or less for more than 15 minutes in duration, have been identified and are currently being notified.

Based on this information, some people will be quarantining. We will be continuing our classes as regularly scheduled.

We are informing you so that you are aware of the situation. We will continue to stay in contact with the Shiawassee Health Department and monitor this situation closely and keep you informed. Please continue to monitor members of your household for onset of symptoms related to COVID-19, including fever, cough, difficulty breathing, headache, or new fatigue. If you note any change in the health of your child, please call your regular medical provider.

We must protect the confidentiality of these individuals. We are moving forward under the guidance of the Health Department and that all measures have been taken to protect the wellbeing of your child(ren).
