Adopt-A-Door Safety Campaign

When it comes to safety in the classroom, it is necessary we take every possible step to make that happen. With recent events weighing heavily on our hearts and minds, the PTA, with the help of local first responders and school leaders, is determined to make positive changes to ensure a safe learning environment for everyone. Over the summer, we are hoping to install Nightlock lockdown devices, as one measure of safety. The Nightlock systems are used to quickly create safe places, in every building. Each system is approximately \$100 including installation. We will need approximately 150 systems to cover the safety needs of all three schools. Please help us in this endeavor to keep our students and staff safe.

Our goal is \$15,000. Any donations raised above that goal will be used to offset costs for additional safety items including, but not limited to:

- Window blinds for external and internal windows
- Additional safety training for all staff
