Dear Byron Area Schools Families,

Last evening, Governor Whitmer announced the Michigan Department of Health & Human Services order which requires the learning for all high school students to be in a virtual format, effective Wednesday, November 18th through Tuesday, December 8th. This order also suspends all athletics and extracurricular activities, which will be effective immediately through at least December 8th.

What does this mean for Byron?

- We will continue as planned to resume in-person learning for our middle school students (7th and 8th grades) beginning tomorrow, November 17th.
- We will continue to offer in-person instruction for our elementary school students (K – 6th grades).
- All learning for our high school students (9th – 12th grades) will utilize our virtual format of Google Suite.
 - For those high school students without technology access, we will be allowing students to work from our Cafeteria.
 - Students will need to continue to wear a facial covering and follow social distance requirements.
- Grab and go breakfasts and lunches will continue to be available for pick-up for our enrolled students on Wednesdays each week.

We will continue to monitor our school and local data with respect to the COVID-19 virus. We will continue to provide updates as they become available.
