The Byron Area Schools district is seeking applications for the current vacant Board of Education trustee position. An individual will be appointed to fill the vacant position until the winner of the November 2022 election is certified and takes the oath of office. That person will serve out the remaining partial term through December 31, 2024.

To be an eligible candidate a person must:

- Be a Michigan resident for at least 30 days and live in the school district
- Be a registered voter in the school district
- Be 18 years or older
- Be a U.S. citizen

Interested persons must send a letter to the Superintendent of Byron Area Schools at 312 W. Maple Ave., Byron, MI 48418. The letter must express a person's interest and their qualifications for the position and must be received no later than 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 31, 2021. Letters of interest may also be sent as email attachments to [cassiday@byron.k12.mi.us](mailto:cassiday@byron.k12.mi.us).

Following a review of the submitted materials the board will schedule interviews with selected candidates. Not all candidates for the board vacancy will be interviewed.

The role of a Board of Education member is to:

- Advocate for students and public schools within the community and at state and national levels
- Monitor the district's performance and keep the public informed and engaged
- Work with the superintendent to set, guide and implement education policies and goals
