To be an eligible candidate a person must:

- > Be a Michigan resident for at least 30 days and live in the school district
- > Be a registered voter in the school district
- ➤ Be 18 years old or older
- ➤ Be a U.S. citizen

Interested persons must send a letter to the Interim Superintendent of Byron Area Schools at 312 W. Maple Ave., Byron, MI 48418. The letter must express a person's interest and their qualifications for the position and must be received no later than 3:00 p.m. on Monday, February 5, 2024. Letters of interest may also be sent as email attachments to byronsupt@byron.k12.mi.us.

Following a review of the submitted materials the board will interview all qualified candidates at the February 14, 2025 regular Board Meeting. The board members will appoint the new member by majority vote.

- Monitor the district's performance and keep the public informed and engaged
- Work with the superintendent to set, guide and implement education policies and goals
